

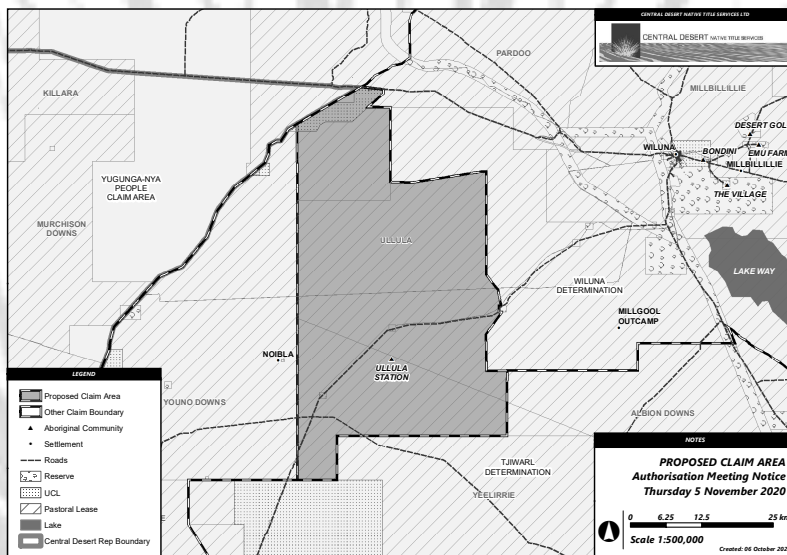
MEETING NOTICE

NEW NATIVE TITLE CLAIM

Authorisation Meeting

WHERE: Moonlight Hall, Wotton Street, Wiluna
DATE: Thursday, 5 November 2020
TIME: After the “South of Windidda” Authorisation Meeting and no later than 1:00pm

AGENDA

1. Background

- 1.1. Central Desert Native Title Services Ltd (**Central Desert**) received a ‘request for assistance’ under section 203BB of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) from the Wiluna native title holders to file and progress a native title claim in the Federal Court of Australia. Central Desert has agreed to provide that assistance.

1.2. A proposed new native title claim that is situated west of the Tarlpa determination area and includes the Ululla pastoral lease, part of Youno Downs pastoral lease and an area of unallocated Crown Land is ready to be filed.

1.3. Before a new native title claim can be filed, those people on the claim must meet and 'authorise' one or more of that group to file the new claim on behalf of everyone. This is called an 'Authorisation Meeting'.

2. Update on Research and Consultation to date

2.1. Central Desert will provide an update on the process of research and consultation that has been undertaken to prepare for the Authorisation Meeting and the filing of a new native title claim.

3. Authorisation to bring the new native title claim

3.1. **Claim boundary** – the proposed new claim covers the area shown in the map attached to this notice.

3.2. **Claim Group Description** – this is how the people who will be included in the claim will be described.

3.3. **Applicant** – the meeting will need to choose a person or people to be the 'Applicant'. It is the Applicant's job to bring the native title application on behalf of all the other people on the claim.

3.4. **Claim Name** – the people on the claim will need to choose a name for the claim which will be how the claim is referred to by other people and by the courts.
