



Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Bill

Central Desert Native Title Services supports Aboriginal people having the final say on what happens to their cultural heritage. Aboriginal people have the authority and strong cultural responsibility to protect and care for Country and significant sites for current and future generations.

In 2021 the WA State Government will introduce the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Bill to parliament. In its current form the Bill will Not prevent the destruction of cultural heritage that drew the global community's attention in 2020 with the destruction of rock shelters at Juukan Gorge.

Aboriginal people have a **Heritage Protection Plan** that will stop the destruction without stopping development. A website has been created to promote understanding of the issue, the website makes it easy to access the facts and stay up to date with what is happening.
