

HAVE YOUR SAY ON ABORIGINAL CULTURAL HERITAGE ACT 2021 CO-DESIGN

The State Government is calling for comment on <u>regulations and guidelines</u> in relation to the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act 2021* (ACH Act).

The new act was passed in December 2021 but does not meet the threshold of free, prior and informed consent – and the final decision concerning contested Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Management Plans lies with the Aboriginal Affairs Minister.

Although the bill has been passed, the State is now engaged in consultation regarding the act's regulations and guidelines, embarking on phase three this month.
